



We have been working hard to prepare our studio to be a safe dance environment for your children upon their return in September. The policies and guidelines listed below adhere to all government safety requirements and Dance Safe Organization recommendations.



UPON ARRIVAL:

- For dancers in Kinderdance (3yrs) and Tiny Toes (4yrs), one parent is asked to remain in class with their child and to wear a mask for the duration of the class. This is to help their child to remain in their specific dancing square, assisting them with bathroom breaks, and ensuring social distancing behaviour throughout the class.
- We have created separate, marked entrances and exits, as well as directional markings in the hallways to ensure a safe flow of traffic throughout the studio.
- Masks are required within the studio facility common areas at all times.
- Our staff will be welcoming your children upon entrance into the studio lobby to ensure proper hand sanitization is practiced and masks are worn before entry into the facility.
- Changerooms are off limits and dancers will be asked to come to class ready to dance with their hair tied back off their face and outfit on. Dancers will store all personal belongings in their TPA teal sling bags provided, and drop their outdoor shoes on the mat or rack at the door. Changing will not be required between classes. If multiple classes are scheduled for a dancer, a single dance uniform will be communicated in future emails.



IN STUDIO:

- All studios have been sectioned off into taped square spaces to ensure safe distancing at six feet apart.
- Masks are required to enter and exit the building, but not while dancing in the studio spaces. Teachers will ensure physical distancing is maintained throughout the class.
- No partner work will be required throughout the dance classes.
- All Primary Division students will be given individual prop packages which will be included in their registration fees.
- For October classes, students will receive their own barre cover and yoga mat and are required to bring them to each class.



ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Only one dancer is permitted in a bathroom at any time. Proper hand washing and sanitizing policies and procedures will be posted throughout the facility and by all sinks. Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- Breaks will be scheduled in between classes to ensure studios are cleaned and disinfected, as well as to help manage studio congestion. Thorough cleaning of the entire facility will be done daily.
- Upon Fall registration, all parents will be required to sign a waiver to ensure all policies and procedures are understood and followed for the safety of all faculty members and dance families.
